The theme for Art Camp for Kids 2010 is "Going Native - Native American Art". During camp, children will learn about the kind of art used by Native American tribes. Projects will include authentic Tee-Pees and the symbolism behind the artwork. We will make wall hangings from clay and medicine bags and deer horn necklaces out of real buck skin, leather and deer horn. We will make a spiritual Sundance Skull that was used during their Pow-Wows. And finally, we will make Symbol Stepping Stones. And, of course there will be a camp tee shirt project. We are excited about this year's camp and are sure that the children will enjoy learning about the Native American Indians and the different art forms that were part of their culture.

There will be eight (8) campers per class giving each child an opportunity to learn in a small group appropriate to their own age group. The younger group will have a class in the morning and the older children in the afternoon. Times are 9:00 AM until Noon and 1:00 PM until 4 PM. A mid-morning and afternoon snack will be served. Below is a list of classes offered so your child may choose any or all of the projects he/she wishes to learn about. The cost is \$20 per class.
